



This drawing is the approved North End Traffic Management Plan. It was approved by Council and the OMB after months of negotiations between the former North End Neighbourhood association, with many public meetings, door to door canvassing and debate. Some parts of the plan have been changed by the City after it was approved. The new neighbourhood association, NENa, is participating in a one day session about the traffic plan on Monday Dec. 11th 2017 at the Bennetto Community Centre. This will be a drop-in meeting with City Traffic Planner Steve Molloy who will be there from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM, Councillor Farr will be there from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM and NENa will also be on hand to provide information. Come ask your questions and find out what is happening.

We encourage all residents to learn about the traffic plan, how it might change in the future, and how the developments on Piers 6, 7 and 8 may impact traffic on residential streets in the North End neighbourhood during construction on the Piers and after the new planned commercial and residential developments come on stream.
